Strategic Intent

- Continue to prioritize initial attack and support emerging incidents.
- Maintain situational awareness in anticipation of critical fire weather events and associated resource needs.
- Allocate resources to augment critical missions and expedite incident objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):

Priority	Fire	Unit	IC	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Lower Sugarloaf/ Labor Mountain	WA-OWF	Sexton	Level 2 and 1 evacuations are in effect. Critical power infrastructure threatened. Road, trail, facility, and area closures.
3	Moon Complex	OR-RSF	Riener	Level 2 and 1 evacuations are in effect. Road, trail, and area closures. Historic and recreational waterway values threatened.
4	Rattlesnake/Lynx Mountain	WA-COA	Kicklighter	Level 3, 2, and 1 evacuations are in effect. Road, trail, and area closures. Timber and Tribal values threatened.
5	Crown Creek/ Katy Creek	WA-NES/ WA-COF	Cowger	Level 3, 2, and 1 evacuations are in effect. Natural and timber resources threatened.
6	Emigrant	OR-WIF	Conrad	Road, trail, and area closures. Natural and timber resources, and hydroelectric infrastructure threatened.
