TITLE: Providing Equity for IMT2 Assignments in the Rocky Mountain Geographic Area

Issue: There are instances based on fire activity and team rotations, where discrepancy in the number of assignments between Type II Teams in the geographic area may exist. These discrepancies inhibit: all teams being well exercised and practiced, out of balance workload for teams (one or more Teams having a high number of assignments), disparity in trainee development and succession planning opportunity, and other potential unforseen pitfalls.

Status: The three ICT2's have discussed the issue, and we are unanimously in agreement of the following recommendation. We believe it is important to highlight solid and cooperative relationships between all Teams, which facilitate the sharing of ideas and identifying workable solutions for issues that arise.

Recommendation: When disparity of mobilizations arises (2 or more) between any Type II Teams, the following should occur:

- Team(s) with higher number of assignments will become the last to be mobilized.
- Once Teams(s) with the lowest number of assignments is mobilized, Team will resume normal rotation order.
- GPC Zone assignments are considered in the Team C total mobilization numbers.
- If PL3 (Zone) prevents Team C's availability, process only applies to Teams A/B. *RMA Mobilization guide will reflect this language for 2012.
- Team C will be the first team assigned within the GPC Zone at all Preparedness Levels (PL) when available.
