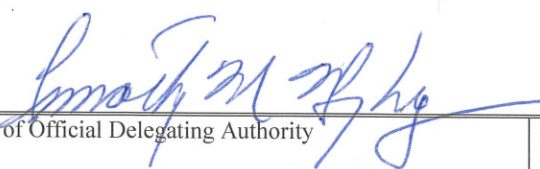

Narrative and Limitations (if any)?

This delegation replaces a Delegation of Authority signed by the Assistant Director, Fire and Aviation, on May 24, 2012, for approval of wildfire decisions. It also replaces sections of the 1203 Delegation of Authority Manual (Appendix 1, Page 97, Rel. 1-1717, dated 07/14/2009) pertinent to approval of the Wildland Fire Situation Analysis (WFSa) and the Wildland Fire Implementation Plan (WFIP).

This delegation provides for wildfire decision approval to district and field office managers for fires on BLM lands, and to the Alaska Fire Service Manager and Alaska Fire Service Fire Management Officers for non-BLM Department of the Interior lands and Alaska Native Lands in Alaska (see Attachment 1). Decision approval may not be redelegated below these levels. Decision approval is delegated to these levels because local managers generally have the most detailed knowledge of fire conditions and close interaction with incident management teams.
