2023 Summary:

Casper Dispatch experienced a below average fire season having 128 fires for 3,603 acres. This was well below our 10-year average of 271 starts for 57,668 acres. Our first fire occurred March 30th and our last fire occurred December 18th. The dispatch center only supported one Type 3 incident. This was the slowest fire season in regard to both number of fires and acres burned, since Rawlins Dispatch and Casper Dispatch combined.

The year started with above average snowpack and cooler than average temperatures. The spring and early summer we saw widespread wetting rains across the dispatch zone. Our fire indices never reached critical levels due to the amount of moisture we received. The fuels across the zone didn't start drying out until middle to end of July, which was our busiest month with 43 fires. The end of the July we saw the largest fire this year, the Pine Ridge fire in Goshen County for 563 acres.


Casper Dispatch mobilized firefighting resources to support out of area incidents starting in January and continued to do that into December. In February, the dispatch zone was regularly sending firefighters to the Southern Area for prescribed burning. By April and May we sent firefighting resources to the Southwest, southern Rocky


Mountain areas, and Canada. In June and into the rest of summer we started mobilizing resources within the Rocky Mountain area, while still sending suppression and support resources to wildfires throughout the nation.



Aviation Summary:

Helicopter 8BH came on contract June 20th in Rawlins, WY. Their contract ended September 9th, but they were extended until September 30th. Their first fire was the Chris Mountain fire in Pagosa Springs, then they were prepositioned in Craig. They did come back and helped with the Burdick RX that High Deseret did this summer. After that they went to Cody and Montana for a few days before returning to Craig for a good portion of the summer. They ended their contract in Cave Junction, OR on the Smith River Complex. H-8BH transported 265 passengers, 16,096 gallons of water. Out of the 103 days on contact this year, they spent 98 days on the road.

Helicopter 2FS came on contract June 5th at Duncan Helibase and their contract ended October 3rd. They supported firefighters in the Cody Dispatch and Casper Dispatch zones. They had a total of 20 missions, two of those were non-fire related one of which was a repeater mission on the Bighorns, and another was a helispot improvement on Laramie Peak. H-2FS transported 336 passengers and delivered 5,471 gallons of water.

Casper SEAT Base opened June 17th and closed October 3rd and was home to T-889 and T-832. They flew a total of 14 fires and delivered 34,000 gallons of retardant. They supported fires in Wyoming, South Dakota and Nebraska.

Rock Springs SEAT Base opened end of July 25th and we closed it September 30th. We did not have SEATs at Rock Springs until August 31st. T-839 and T-882 were housed there for the remainder of the SEAT Base operation for 2023. They flew on 2 fires and delivered 11,265 gallons of retardant.
