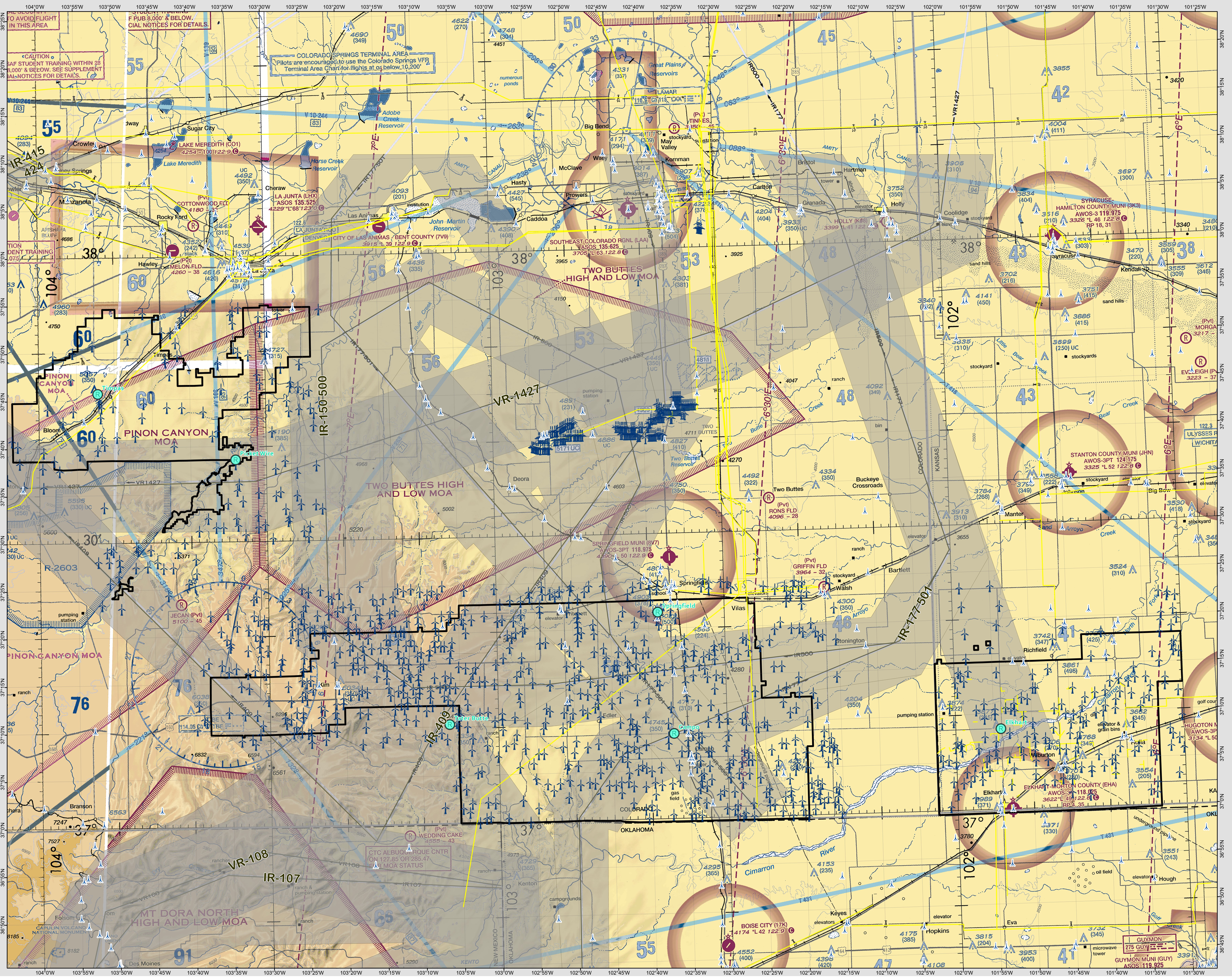


Cimarron and Comanche National Grasslands Aviation Hazard Map

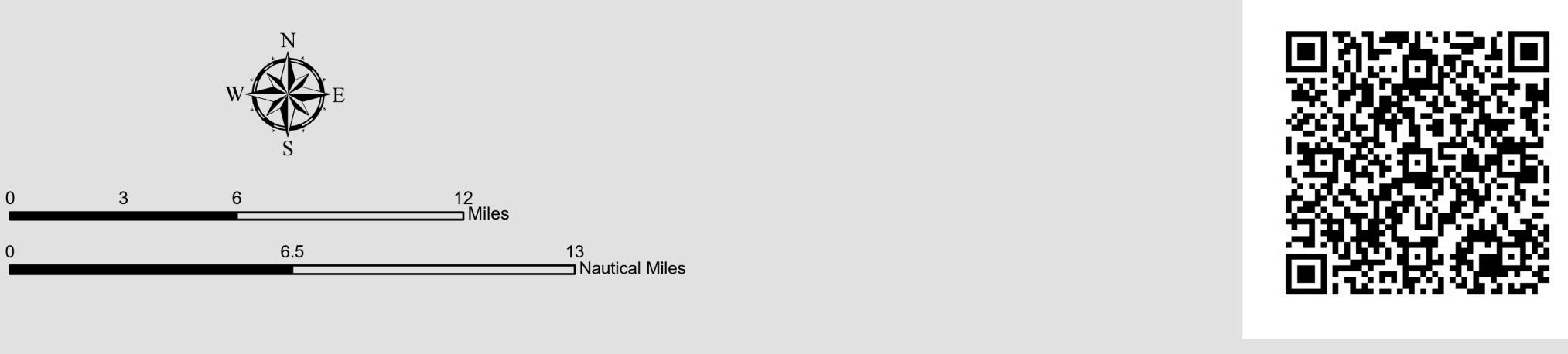
