

Fire Incident Mapping Tools (FIMT) version 10.0.11 - What is New:

1. Not an extension. Now it is an Add-In. No longer needs Administrative rights.
2. Installs for both ArcGIS v10.0 and v10.1. Seems to work with 10.2.x.
3. Implemented new GSTOP policies / guidelines.
4. There is a new GeoDB template.
 - ArcGIS v10 GeoDB
 - Updated domains – added items, spelling corrections, alphabetical
 - Updated Anno Feature Classes - Reference scale 1:24,000
5. Allows install to be on any drive, but now really stores under personal space.
6. Occasional case where fonts not loading is fixed. As well, ways around loading fonts documented.
7. Added new FirePoints and FireLines symbols.
 - Includes Road as a Controlled Line
 - i. Some people see this similar to requested “Drivable Break”.
8. Adjusted dialog boxes to work better with different screen settings.
9. Make small syntax changes to dialogs that had errors or needed clean up.
10. Loading Coordinate Table to layout automatically sets font to Courier to be fixed spaces so it displays correctly.
11. Occasionally when splitting lines, the color differentiation would not appear. Fixed when converted to an Add-In.
12. Removed Anno NULL label if user did not type in label value in a FirePoint feature.
13. Updated Ownership Report. Works with Definition Queries or selected sets. Removes temp tables when done. Can run more than once in the same ArcMap session.
14. File GeoDBs set extent limits when small. Fixed by deleting domain limit as saving and allow the automatic save process rebuild to larger extent.
15. Make all activated tools appear depressed when activated.
16. Updated / enhanced “Updated Symbols and Lables” dialog.
17. Copy Perimeter (poly) to Line dialog removes the available line themes to not show FIMT line themes so there is no chance to make a mistake.
18. Cleaned up Copy to History dialog. History works very well.
19. Corrected the feature level metadata form.
20. Reduce Perimeter Report size – limits unused assignments.
21. Draw History to use FIMT Color ramp and to automatically expand Hist_FirePolygon theme to show legend when depressed, turns off when deactivated. As well, set a more standard date format.
22. Fixed when exporting GDB to SHP, Hist feature classes were loosing SnapShot_Time.
23. Stopped the beep when Copy to FireLine captured the data.
24. Turned off the selection of History feature dataset by default on creation and load.
25. Added Rehab symbols to styleset - still need to document their use.
26. Fixed acreage sums on Fire History Report. There was some double counting before.
