Scout opportunities for direct line construction along the fires edge. GPS all hand lines and turn in to situation unit. Inventory hose and GPS pump location.

VICC #3 - Working on Division M. Mop up 50 feet in, patrol and hold fire line so fire does not spread to the North. Inventory hose and GPS pump location.

KYMA# 1328 - Crew continues to prep line on Division H of Butler Fire, for possible burnout operation.
