- NC-NCF crew is assigned to the Incendiary Creek fire, near Kooskie, Idaho.
- NC-NCS crew is assigned to the Nez Perce National Forest for Initial Attack.

**TODAY'S CREW ASSIGNMENTS:**

- VA is assigned to the Lolo Complex, Branch II Div X, keep fire north of Hwy 12, support structure protection as needed, mop-up 2 chains into interior.
- TN is assigned to the Lolo Complex, Branch I Div C, scout opportunities for line construction going as direct as possible..
- MS crew - Reassigned this morning, demobing from present location near Dillon Montana and travelling to Helena Montana.
- NC-NCF assigned to the Incendiary Creek Fire for initial attack today.
- NC-NCS re-assigned from Ought-7 fire to ABCD Misc Initial Attack on the Nezperce NF. Today they changed locations twice on the Forest before this evening. Lightning storms last night has resulted in a number of new starts. The Forest was trying to sort out the best position for the NC- NCS crew today...

MESSAGE:

Jim and I met with folks at the Nez Perce N.F. Dispatch Center and folks at Expanded Dispatch in Grangeville Idaho. While there the NC-NCS crew arrived for their second reposition of the day. We met with them and assisted in their resupply at the Forest cache in preparation for initial attack efforts (there are a number of new starts today on the Nez Perce NF from lightning last night – the last of the Grangeville jumpers were dispatched to fires while we were there...).
