- C-51 (VICC Interagency Crew 1) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch III, Div R, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Day Shift)
- C-52 (VICC Interagency Crew 5) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch V, Div P, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Day Shift)
- C-53 (NC ECA 1) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch III, Div S, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Night Shift)
- C-54 (SCMA 2) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch III, Div S, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Night Shift)

**TODAY'S CREW ASSIGNMENTS:**

- C-50 (MS Interagency Crew #3) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch V, Div Q, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA [spiked at camp in Yosemite – Crane Flat], (Day Shift), Coordinate efforts with neighbor DIVS, Utilize MIST in wild and scenic river corridor, take wx obs and forward to comm, hold fire north of Hwy 120, Prep line along Hwy 120 to Crane Flat Helibase and prep to division break. Burn out as necessary.
- C-51 (VICC Interagency Crew 1) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch III, Div S, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Day Shift), construct dozer line from Hazel Green Ranch to Pilot's Peak. Assist with structure protection along Hwy 120 and Yosemite Rd.
- C-52 (VICC Interagency Crew 5) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch V, Div S, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Day Shift), Assess and prepare for structure defense along Evergreen Rd. including Evergreen Lodge, Camp Mather, Camp Towanga and Aspen Valley. Early intake and points between. South of Evergreen Rd. to Hwy 120.
- C-53 (NC ECA 1) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch III, Div S, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Night Shift), Patrol and hld line along Pilot Ridge, burnout as necessary.
- C-54 (SCMA 2) is assigned to Rim Fire Base Camp, Branch III, Div S, near Groveland RD, Stanislaus NF, CA, (Night Shift) Patrol and hold line along Pilot Ridge, burnout as necessary.
- C-55 (BIA Eastern OK) is assigned to Rim Fire Tuolumne Base Camp, Branch II, Div D, Tuolumne, CA, (Night Shift), scout rd systems and improve fire break, scout opportunities for indirect line construction, monitor fire spread in Tuolumne River drainage.
- C-56 (AOICC Interagency Crew 6) is assigned to Rim Fire, Tuolumne Base Camp, Tuolumne CA, Branch II, Div F, near Tuolumne, CA, (Day Shift), Improve 3NO7 road from Cottonwood rd to 3NO1 road. Improve 3NO9 road for firing operations. Continue constructing dozer line from Fahey meadow to 3NO1 rd.

**INJURIES:** None today. Employee (NC-ECA #1; crew 53) with twisted knee was demobed and flew out of sacramento this morning at 0600 am.
