Team on-call rotation is as follows:

- The rotation begins at 0001 Sunday the beginning of the two-week pay period schedule and runs through 2400 hours on Saturday two-weeks later. Each team will be on rotation for a full two-week period.
- Once one team is assigned to an incident, the other team becomes on-call until the assigned team is released. If an assigned team is released during its scheduled on-call period, it will resume on-call status as soon as the team is available for assignment, and will serve the remainder of its scheduled rotation period, or until it receives an assignment.

- The request shall go to the Team Coordinator, Mark Ruggiero, SER Emergency Services Coordinator.
- The Team Coordinator will contact the available IC.
- The IC will identify team members and communicate the Team Roster to the Team Coordinator.
- The Regional Coordinator after receiving the names of the team members will relay the information to the Park or responsible dispatch office for processing the appropriate name requests through the dispatch channels.
