They took over the Vinegar Fire yesterday at 1900. The crew should be comfortable in camp, soft grass, shade, showers etc. but the fire is in the Wilderness on some steep country. Firefighting may be challenging.

FL ST #2 is assigned to IA. They responded to a smoke yesterday which turned out to be a false alarm. Got a flat tire during the response.

I'm traveling to Grants Pass today to have a face-to-face with the FL ST#2 crew. Dave Berens will visit with GA NF#1 and Everglades who are located in the north part of the state as I head south.

We ended up coordinating with the local district office to get this fixed and paid for locally. I will be travelling to La Grand, OR today to meet up with the Georgia and Florida crews.

Fire is relatively well contained. RH is extremely low with effectively no recover through the night. Erratic fire behavior within the lines occurred yesterday resulting in slop over. Quick responses from crews kept the fire from running beyond containment. With the same weather conditions, potential is extremely high for similar occurrences.

GA SC 1 crewmember taken to medical clinic due to lung inflammation yesterday is back on line today.

- TN-TNC-T2IA: Assigned to Div. M, secure hotspots near DP-10 and identify and secure pockets of heat within 300' in jackstraw (down and crisscrossed black spruce) with potential to threaten containment lines. Be bear aware and report any encounters to Ops for formal documentation.
- MS Interagency #1-MIC: Assigned to Branch II Div. F, Crews will secure and mop up fire line from yesterday's burn operation in Div F and continue to the west.
- VA-VIC-T2IA: Assigned to Fire 475 Joint Lake, Construct line around spots and mop up spots. Limited resources are available. Mop up and access in jackstrawed timber will be labor intensive. Fire is burning deep (into the tundra) and extensive mop up is necessary.
- NC-NCS Asheville #1 and NC-NCF #2: Assigned to Div. T, continue with completion of indirect line construction from Portage Creek to Medicine Lake, Locate and construct medevac spots as needed, Continue construction of hose lay. There will be little active fire spread today due to precipitation from yesterday, making for great conditions to prepare for firing operations in coming days.

**INJURIES: None**

**MESSAGE: Jim and I will visit the ICP in Venete AK where the VA crew is assigned.**

**We continue to receive very good reports on our southern region crews.**

**INJURIES:** No injuries reported. The crew member from the FS Tribal Interagency #1 was re-evaluated yesterday by the doctor and was determined to be in the latter stages of the stomach flu. He will be resting today and was cleared to be on the line tomorrow.

**MESSAGE:** Belanger stayed in Yreka yesterday administering to the crew member at the hospital and working with comps/claims from the Type 1 Team and the Buying Team on miscellaneous items. Kile met with the crews last evening after end of shift. This morning, Kile/Belanger attended this morning briefing, followed up with comps/claims, and met with plans/demob for making flight arrangements for the NICC jet. We were briefed that our crews would need to be in Redding by 1000 hrs on Monday (travel day), however that would force the crews to be released on their 14<sup>th</sup> day, being Sunday, in order to handle all of the logistical/ground support needs of demobing from Camp, travel to the ICP (finance), and then travel to Redding and stay overnight in Redding in order to be prepared for a Monday morning flight. Due to location of where the camp facilities are to the ICP and then to Redding we estimate it would take a minimum of 9-11 hrs of demob time for all five crews. We recommended and Plans concurred that the NICC jet needs to be scheduled for a Tuesday morning flight from Redding. Operations needs the crews for Sunday and this suggestion dove-tails in with allowing appropriate time to demob from the incident. We are pending from expanded dispatch the Team's request.
