**MESSAGE:** Crews 35-37 arrived at ICP at approximately 1430, crews 33-34 arrived at ICP at approximately 1745. The module only had three buses to shuttle them, so they had to make two trips. They crews are planned to have twenty-five rental vehicles for transportation since access is limited to the fire line. The rentals should arrive tomorrow but they can utilize the buses for transportation until rentals arrive. Management of the incident will begin transition to McGowan's Type 1 Team tomorrow. Specific assignments for the crews are being finalized tonight. The crews will be retrofitted with tools and chainsaws in the morning. IARR (t) Collins is in travel status and is set to arrive to ICP on the morning of 8/23.
