MORALE OF CREWS:

After yesterday's extreme fire behavior, crews still have great morale and are getting diverse experiences rarely seen on western details. Major changes in fire behavior and perimeter will provide a day of change for all.

INJURIES:

No new injuries.

MESSAGE: All crews are likely to be in spike camps again this evening.

KY 1, VA 1, and NC 1 are all planned to be spiked at Lowman tonight.

VA 2 and NC 2 will be spiked at DP70.

Assignments for crews are being determined as information on new perimeter is scouted.

Possibility of thunderstorms this afternoon. Extreme fire behavior and growth is expected if thunderstorms do develop in the fire area.
