LOCATION & ASSIGNMENT OF CREWS

PORCUPINE – UT-MLF-006211

STATE: Utah

Fire is located approximately 7 miles northeast of North Fork, ID and 15 miles north of Salmon, ID. The fire is burning in subalpine fire and lodgepole pine. Active group torching with uphill runs and spotting. No burn out operation was conducted yesterday. All hand crews were moved to the north end of the fire to construct containment lines. Type 2 Incident. IC – B. Hoffman. This fire is 20% contained.

STATE: Idaho

Fire is located 8 miles north of Idaho City. Timber (grass and understory). Fire behavior has remained very active during the day. Late in the afternoon yesterday, the fire made a run on the W flank S of Hwy 17 and remained active at night. Inversions lifted around noon yesterday, followed by an increase in fire behavior, noted by rapid surface fire spread, active burning in drainages, increased torching and spotting 1/4 to 1/2 mile. Type 1 incident. IC – Chadwick. This fire is 50% contained.

MESSAGE:

FL-ST-03 continued to patrol and secure existing lines. B. Loth continues to stage nearby.

AL-MA-01 continued to patrol and secure existing lines. *This crew has been spiked out for 4 days.*

FL-ST-02 continued to secure the lines around a historic cabin, mop up spot fires and establish contingencies, and prepare for aerial ignitions and bucket work. *This crew has been spiked out for 4 days.*

GA-ST-02 and PR-MA-04 are continuing to construct contingency lines on the southern end of the fire to protect the community of the 4th of July. J. Lowe and C. Pierce continue to stage nearby. **GA-ST-02 and PR-MA-01 were made available for reassignment at end of shift today and will be demobilized tomorrow morning, 08/23. The Stein Fire IMT plans to release all resources by end of shift on 08/25.**

IARR(t) Hunter contacted the GBCC crew desk to gather intel on potential reassignments. He was informed of plans to reassign GA-ST-02 and PR-MA-04 to the Pioneer Fire if they are demobilized from the Stein Fire. IARR(t) Hunter also contacted the Eastern Idaho Interagency expanded dispatch and was informed of their plans to keep AL-MA-01 assigned to the Toponce Creek Fire until they time out on 08/26.

IARR Berens traveled to the Pioneer Fire to check in with FL-ST-03.

Tentative plans are to have all crews demob by 08/26, travel to Boise and return their rentals and tools on 08/27 and depart for Tampa on the NICC jet on 08/28.
