Please find the attached form for submitting nominations for the Nevada Type 3 Incident Management Team IC's, team members, trainee and alternate positions. Supervisors should approve and forward the nominations **to their respective Agency Representative of the Nevada Interagency Fire Operations Committee.**

Please have all nomination forms submitted no later than January 13, 2012.

Individual and Agency commitment to team participation is the key component in making the Nevada Interagency Type 3 Incident Management teams successful. Trainee nominations for all team positions are strongly encouraged. We are also looking for alternates who may be called upon to fill in for regular team members that cannot be available for a call-up period. Type 3 IMT call-up periods will be determined after nominations are received and the number of teams has been decided. Our goal is to again status four teams on one week call-up periods.

Nominees for positions will make a one year commitment to team participation and are expected to be available for call-out during a set rotation period. Rotation dates for 2012 are tentatively scheduled to begin May 11th and end September 27th. Type 3 Incident Management Team Recruitment and Nomination Process Guidelines.

1. **November:** Nominations for all team positions will be sent out.
2. **Early-January:** List of verified nominations due to Agency Representatives. Once verified, nominations are forwarded to Western Great Basin Coordination Center and posted on the website.
3. **Mid-January:** Nevada Interagency Fire Operations Committee members and ICs select IMT members.
4. **After Selection Meeting:** ICs will notify team members of selection and call out rotation. Rosters and rotation are posted on WGBCC website.
5. **Early May:** Annual Team meetings.

NEVADA TYPE 3 INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM MEMBER RECRUITMENT REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements will be used for the selection of the Nevada Type 3 Incident Management Teams.

The commitment requirement for Type 3 Teams will be for **one year**.

After one year in a position, incumbents will need to reapply and compete for a new team position.

<u>Positions</u>	<u>Minimum Qualifications Requirement</u>
Incident Commander	Incident Commander Type 3 (ICT3)
Safety	Line Safety Officer (SOFR)
Operations	Strike Team Leader or Task Force Leader or Division Group Supervisor (recommended).
Air Operations	Helicopter Manager or Air Tactical Group Supervisor or Strike Team/Task Force Leader or ICT4 or Helibase Manager
Logistics	No Minimum qualification (Red Book 11/4-5)
Plans	No Minimum qualification (Red Book 11/4-5)
Finance	No Minimum qualification (Red Book 11/4-5)
Information	No Minimum qualification (Red Book 11/4-5)
Information Technology (IT)	No Minimum qualification, IT experience or diverse computer skills required
