Great Lakes Compact (MN, WI, MI) Forecast Fire Danger for 1-30-17: Low. **Fire Weather:** An Alberta Clipper low will slide east/southeast through the compact into Tuesday creating areas of mainly light snow over the northern and eastern Great Lakes. Snow showers or flurries are possible behind the low Tuesday into Wednesday as colder air sinks into the compact to begin February. The next chance of precipitation arrives this weekend with areas of light snow expected.

Big Rivers Compact (IA, MO, IL, IN) Forecast Fire Danger for 1-30-17: Low to moderate. **Fire Weather:** Mainly dry conditions are expected this week with colder temperatures sinking into the compact later in the week. The next chance of precipitation arrives through weekend with heavier amounts possible over the southern tier.

Northeast Compact (NY, MA, CT, RI, VT, NH, ME) Forecast Fire Danger for 1-30-17: Low. **Fire Weather:** Areas of mainly light snow will affect the compact from west to east Tuesday into Wednesday as a low drifts through southern New England. Areas of lake effect snow are expected through the end of the week along with colder temperatures remaining in place.

Mid-Atlantic Compact (OH, PA, NJ, DE, MD, WV) Forecast Fire Danger for 1-30-17: Low. **Fire Weather:** Areas of mainly light snow are expected over the northern tier of the Mid-Atlantic States and higher elevations of the Appalachians Monday evening into Wednesday. Lake effect snow will persist over northwestern Pennsylvania and northeastern Ohio Wednesday night into Friday. More widespread precipitation is expected to move through on Sunday.






Previous 7 Day Accumulated Precipitation




Previous 14 Day % of Normal Precipitation




7 Day Forecast Precipitation Totals




Forecast Fire Danger for 1-30-17



6 to 10 Day Precipitation Outlook





6 to 10 Day Temperature Outlook



