

33 Incident Support Organizations

Agency administrators are responsible for emergency operations, however the units FMO has responsibility for the incident support organization (ISO). ILC will have dispatch operating plans that include authorities, roles, and responsibilities for all dispatching activities, including routine and emergency operations.

33.1 Initial and Extended Attack Dispatch Organization (Types 3, 4 and 5 Incidents)

This chart represents communications flow when an initial or extended attack for a Type 3, 4 or 5 Incidents.



33.2 Type 1 or 2 Incidents

Type 1 or 2 Incidents are the responsibility of the Agency Administrator and will be managed from a location designated by the Agency Administrator. *The chart below illustrates the communications flow during a Type 2 or Type 1 Incident .*
