Applications will not be considered complete without a master record. For each position you wish to apply for on the team, you will need to submit a new application thru the link. Only one master record is needed per applicant when applying for multiple positions.

The EA Interagency Dispatch Team was established to provide a highly skilled group of dispatch personnel to support wildland fire and all-hazard incident management efforts. The Team has been an excellent representation of the Eastern Area Dispatch community and our commitment to supporting incident management throughout the country.

Team members will serve for a one-year term after which time they will need to reapply if interested in serving on the 2023 Team. Applications will be accepted from all qualified and eligible applicants from the Eastern Area and Nationally. Eastern Area personnel will receive priority consideration for positions.
