


(Fire Danger Area) Pocket Card









Fire Danger Area:

- Bridgeport District
- Fish Spring RAWS
 - Meets NWCG Wx Station Standards

Fire Danger Interpretation:



EXTREME -- Use extreme caution

(Caution) -- Watch for change

Moderate -- Lower Potential, but always be aware

Maximum -- Highest Burning Index by day for 1986 - 2013


Average -- shows peak fire season over 28 years (2102 observations) 90th Percentile -- Only 10% of the 2102 days from 1986 - 2013 had an Burning Index above 88

Local Thresholds - Watch out: Combinations

of any of these factors can greatly increase fire behavior: 20' Wind Speed over 15 mph, RH less than 15%,

Temperature over 90, 1000-Hour Fuel Moisture less than 17

Years to Remember: 2003 2013



Remember what Fire Danger tells you:

- ✓ Burning Index gives day-to-day fluctuations calculated from 2 pm temperature, humidity, wind, daily temperature & rh ranges, and precip duration.
- Wind is part of BI calculation.
- ✓ Watch local conditions and variations across the landscape -- Fuel, Weather, Topography.
- Listen to weather forecasts -- especially WIND.
