| 3        | Elevenmile     | ID-SCF | Martin   | Critical municipal water source, 19 residences threatened                                 |
| 4        | Rapid          | ID-PAF | Stephens | 39 residences, grazing allotments, high recreation area closures, smoke impacts to McCall |
