Predictive Services Update: Lightning coverage widespread E NV and ID. Mix of wet/dry. Thunderstorm downdrafts. Today: Lightning further East to Salmon-Challis NF. More dry than wet. Dryout in NV. More lightning to mountains of ID – wet/dry. Low humidity. Monday: Start drying out. Winds in W NV 25-30 mph.

GBCC Update:

- Minimal IA. 4 new starts for .4 acre. After the IC Call: Large fire growth: 15302 acres
- T3 NV Kane IMT only available for NV. No other teams.
- All GB Buying Teams committed.
- Ely airport construction: moved Jumpers to Winnemucca.
- Available in GB: 2 MAFFS in BOI, 5 AT, 1 VLAT, 3 LP (2 more available at 1630), 22 SEATs (2 d/o), 4 Loads of Jumpers at 4 bases (OGD, MYL, PIH, WMC)
