Agenda Items:

Predictive Services Update: Dry lightning across NE NV, NW UT, West central Utah. Storms beginning later this evening. 1700-1800 through about midnight. This will be mostly dry thunderstorms. Not widespread, but concerning. Weather Service has issues Red Flags out for those thunderstorms. Gusty winds across SW Utah and SE Nevada. Wind speeds to 25-30 mph. Into tomorrow, things start to quiet. Lighter winds tomorrow afternoon. Weekend is high pressure, warmer, lighter winds, and lower RHs.
