Predictive Services:	<p>...Above normal temperatures across the area later this week with record heat across portions of Nevada...</p> <p>High pressure will build across the region through the end of this week ushering in a warming, drying trend. Conditions will continuously warm and dry through the end of the week, with temperatures 10 to 15 degrees above normal by Friday. The warming trend will be most pronounced across western and central Nevada where record high temperatures are forecast by Friday. Overnight RH recovery will be increasingly poor as drier air moves into the region.</p> <p>Confidence in the weather pattern early next week is low, but models suggest that moisture may make its way into western Nevada and southern Idaho beginning Sunday, bringing the potential for thunderstorm activity. Beyond that, high pressure will begin to break down allowing the possibility of a stronger weather system. If this comes to fruition, we could see a period of gusty winds ahead of a strong weather system early next week.</p>
