Fire near the community, near town, made a push and did come into the fuel break. Will take some IHCs into the area making hand line to stop that progress above town, will go direct on that part of the fire. Tying all of the fireline together is going to be difficult due to the terrain.</li> <li>• BRIEF fire synopsis /Critical Incident Information (use Directional vs DIVS's) Fire is primary in wilderness. North side near the community Pine Valley and Central. Burning in the conifer and mountain shrub is not burning. However, it is drying out and may become an issue. Put ffts in the correct place for max effect, terrain and fuels are an issue.</li> <li>• Political Issues / Community Meetings Community meeting continue. Good turnout and keeping them informed and very supportive.</li> <li>• Closures / Evacuations / Public Safety Issues USFS trail closed / volute evacuation for residence / sheriff has been pushing residence to evacuate when possible, and inform them of any threats.</li> <li>• Major Safety Concerns / Injuries / Accidents Where we put FFTR into the fire line due to the terrain and fuels / one accident with gas from a chain saw and skin irritation and 2 heat related minor injuries.</li> </ul>
