A lot of open line on W. flank, has potential to hook around to N. SE flank not as much concern, has burned around Lucky Peak helibase & greenhouses. • Hwy 21 is open but may need to be intermittently closed today. No evacuations at this time. • Powerlines, traffic, public & WUI safety concerns. • Airtankers, T1 helos, T1 crews, T2IA crews are critical needs. • Nothing at this time to demob/share •
