- Granite Creek basin, working in and around structures for prep with unified command and the counties.
- West: burn outs along the highway and doing indirect along Battle Butte. Heavy use of dozer and crews. Made good progress along this area. Secure anchor point in Granite creek drainage.
- Critical Needs: Air attack
- Closures of Hwy 189/191 still in effect. Discussion with county to open the hwy by 1200 today for local traffic.
- 0 accident / 0 injuries: ankle, dehydrated and stomach issue. No time lost.
- Public meeting 100 people, very supportive and another meeting tonight at Pinedale at 1800.
