Drier air pushes into the region by this coming weekend and will spread across the Great Basin, including most of Utah...increasing the possibility of lightning holdovers. Temperatures will be on the rise through next week as high pressure dominates the Great Basin. Moisture may start returning from south to north as early as Tuesday next week for a return of thunderstorms, but timing, coverage and moisture are still uncertain.

- 25 new fires for 5945 acres
- 6482 acres large fire growth
- Below drawdown for crews: 24 IHCs and 35 T2IA committed within the Basin
- Critical shortage of T1 and T2 Helicopters
- VLAT going to Sops
- Requesting additional T1 helicopter will most likely be positioned in Twin Falls, ID

- 5278/26% / 388/1.9M
- Active day yesterday, fire moved considerably to the east
  - Spotted into the Rock Creek Drainage
  - Working with the Sheriff's office on Evacuations
    - Sheriff is standing up his OEC and will be in the IC yurt for face to face
    - Established a shelter location
  - Road system is extensive and will require lots of effort for sweeping the roads – ordered 22 Security Specialists
  - Critical needs
    - Crews: 2 T1, TT2IA, 1 T2
    - 4 strike teams Engines w/leadership
    - 2 T2 Dozers with supervision
