Cold front in GB from N-S next 18 hrs. Wind shift late afternoon over Pioneer and VA Mtn complex. Strong winds in ID. Frontal passage early morning on Pioneer. Won't die down tonight. Moving into N. UT tomorrow morning. VA Mtn Complex will have winds N-NE after midnight moving NE. Precipitation in UT, E. half of NV. Already lightning in NE NV. Dry in ID. Some new starts. Next couple of days lightning suppressed. Thursday – return of lightning.
