RAWS stations showed winds over 40 mph in S. ID, E. NV, and W. UT E. IO and W. WY – winds today 25-35 mph. More seasonal conditions. Winds across W. NV not as strong as past days. Thursday: Thunderstorms UT and AZ. NV South to North. Las Vegas – wet. Dry than wet in Central NV, I-80 corridor to Winnemucca. A lot of lighting going West. Friday – Thunderstorms in ID. Widespread mix of wet and dry. Not super wet. Long-term- drier air/lighting/winds picking up. VA Mtn Complex – critical winds and lo RHs on Friday.
