Some lighting late yesterday and overnight in Central and Eastern NV towards S. UT. Primarily wet. Lightning in the mountains of Central ID, E. OR, Northern Payette NF, Boise NF, ID and WY border. Today: Lightning in E. ID, W. WY. Gusty winds – front approaching. 50 mph downdrafts. NV drier air – gusty in the south 2/3 of NV. Shower activity the past 2-3 days in these areas. Sunday: Strong cold front in ID and UT, WY. Lighting on the Payette, Boise and part of Salmon-Challis NFs. Wetting rains on the Bridger-Teton NF. Winds in UT. Drier air early next week.

 - Exciting day yesterday. Thunder cell sat over NE portion of fire. Some moisture last night. Downdrafts blew it over Rock Creek area. Jumped Payette River. 3000 acres over the river. Not as bad as expected. Difficult with predicted weather today. Changed strategy. Changed Divisions and Branches.
 - West and South: Holding
 - East: Modules putting in contingency line. No significant growth.
