Concern is lightning this afternoon and overnight for NE NV, NW and West Central UT, and SW Id. Dry – not a lot of moisture. SLC and Elko – Red Flag Warning. Gusty winds with thunderstorms. Gusty winds in SW UT and SW NV this afternoon (Strawberry and Overland fires) 30-40 mph. Afternoon gusty winds. Thursday: Winds die down, not much thunderstorm activity through the weekend. Warming temps, decreased winds, decreased RHs. Next week: Isolated thunderstorms. End of Next Week: Monsoonal push – hard to predict where at this point.
