East of North Zone: Lowman and Deadwood drainage – nasty ground. Sunday: winds hot/dry. Fear that fire will take off and run north to Deadwood drainage. A lot of debris coming down on Hwy 17.
- Critical Resource Needs: 3 T1 Crews, 3 T2IA for support on burnout and resources timing out
- Closures: Forest, Hwy 17 closed. Hwy 21 open during the day, closed at night.
