High pressure over the GB – Temperatures increasing over next couple of days. Instability in Central ID mtns. Increased chance of gusty winds in Central ID mtns and moving into S ID and N NV. Monday – on the drier side. Later, deeper moisture in GB Wed and Thurs. Most thunderstorms over UT and W WY. Short term: isolated toward ID - unstable conditions.
