A weak area of low pressure will track across the north for isolated, mix of wet/dry thunderstorms over the higher elevations of central ID. Another low tracks a bit further south on Monday for isolated showers and thunderstorms over southern Idaho, western WY, NE NV and Northern UT. Breezy winds are expected on Sunday across western NV and E ID/W WY, but will remain below critical levels. Moisture continues to move into eastern portions of the GB by midweek for daily afternoon showers and thunderstorms, mainly over the higher terrain and across the south. Western NV and western ID look to remain fairly dry during the period, but could possibly see some isolated dry thunderstorms late in the work week.

 - South Zone DIV GG: Focus point. Major activity. Fire operations.
 - South Zone: No Critical Resource Needs
 - North Zone: Winds not in favor. Last night decided not to burnout the West Flank above the river. Deadwood drainage – runs expected with weather. Could see significant growth. Defensive mode using T1 Helo and Scoopers. Setting up Mobile Retardant Plant for quick turnarounds.
 - North Zone Critical Resource Needs: T1 Helo and T1 and T2IA Crews for complex burnout.
