Showers and thunderstorms in the afternoon - Thunderstorms will be a wet/dry mix in northern NV, northern UT, southern ID, and southeastern UT. Thunderstorms will be dry in north central GBC area. Yesterday we saw gust up to 50mph and today there will be brief isolated wind gusts of 30-40mph with the thunderstorms, otherwise winds will be fairly light. Thunderstorms will develop further east tomorrow. Friday with the front winds will pick up in ID around 20-35mph.
