<b>Predictive Services:</b> Weather update: <b>Gina McGuire</b>	Thunderstorms today further north into Nevada as far north as the Rock Hill fire – strong outflow winds, lightning and only light amounts of rainfall. Thunderstorms continue further south in NV/UT with better chances of rainfall, continued gusty outflow winds and lightning for Briggs/Porcupine/Sand Ledges/Motoqua fires. Stronger west winds 30-40 mph and low RH today across ID with Red Flag Warnings in effect. Breezy W-NW near 25 mph continues Tuesday over ID, northern NV/UT with wetter thunderstorms further south. Thunderstorms/some moisture possible in ID Wed/Thu.

<b>MAC / GBCC Coordinator</b> <b>Dennis Terry</b>	Report from the ASAT. Visiting Elko, Battle Mountain, and Winnemucca today. Will RON Boise tonight. Operationally found no issues. Helped with identifying weaknesses on how helitack transports hazardous materials but a very small concern.	
<b>1</b> <b>Fire: Pioneer</b> <b>IC: Lund, South Zone, Chadwick, North Zone</b>	96,469 / 50% / 2065 / 60 M. Clearly still struggling with the river corridor. Most of the growth on the north zone is to the north and not an issue. Problem is that if it gets on the east side of Bear Valley road (Clear Creek drainage), it could turn back south and head back down into Lowman. Hence the need for the Type 1 crew to burn and hold that road/drainage.	
<b>2</b> <b>Fire: Henry's Creek</b> <b>IC: Berkebile</b>	1500 / 15% / 25% / 150,000.00 The latest is that the fire is 1500 acres plus. 25% contained. The evacuation is lifted and folks are able to return to their houses. Critical needs are a Type 1 crew or a Type 2IA crew for the high country.	

<p><b>3</b>  <b>Fire: Sand Ledges</b>  <b>IC: S. Nielson</b></p>	<p>2500 / 10% / 42 / \$700,000.00  The fire is 2500 plus and 10% contained. A growth from yesterday's 209 of 3,000 acres. A cell parked over the fire and a wind shift expedited the growth. Dozer burn over. Light fuels and the dozer turned into the black but still took flame impingement. Burned some plastic and rendered it unusable. Driver stayed inside and is fine. Critical needs are generally for overhead.</p>
<p><b>4</b>  <b>Fire: Rock Hill</b>  <b>IC: Eric Nolan</b></p>	<p>1764 / 40% / 204 / \$215,000.00  Still working line that hasn't had boots on it yet. Hotshots needed for the high country. If the lines hold they expect containment today.</p>
