Report from the ASAT. Covering Rough, Pioneer and McCall today. Tomorrow schedule for Salmon. Concerns from the visit yesterday to primarily TB are staffing is right at the max.

Fire: Henry's Creek
IC: Berkebile**

43,135 / 20% / 260 / 800,000.00
T3 to turn over the fire at end of shift today to DeMasters. The W and NW side of fire looking pretty secure. The major concern is the NE and SE sides especially with the expected winds out of the north predicted for today. With that there should be significant growth again today. Working with FS for trigger points for numerous closure areas. Safety concerns are terrain, access and fuels. Critical needs include T1 crews, aircraft and heavy equipment.

IC (t) Adell**

100,367 / 40% / 2155 / 63,700,000.00
Securing west side today. North side working its way to an old burn (Lowman). Evaluation still in progress with structure protection group by Hwy 17. BAER still working on assessment near the Hwy 21 corridor. Lund closed out with Chadwick (T2 IC) yesterday and assumed command of the north zone. Community meeting schedule for Centerville on Thursday. Closures still in effect along with public safety concerns-Bow season for Elk so hunters could become an issue.
Injuries/illnesses, 1 injury from personnel falling off the top of a T7 engine. 1 Life Light with chest pains. Still in hospital with diagnosis of Pneumonia.

	Critical needs: T1 crews and Archeologists – crews timing out is of concern.
3 Berry IC: Roide	6,819 / 0% / 116 / \$536,000 Acres updated due to better mapping. Roide T2 Team assumed command 0600 today. Fire remains active. Major Hwy connecting Grant Teton and south entrance of Yellowstone National Park remains closed. Flagg Ranch and 2 campgrounds remain closed. Structure protection for those entities otherwise fire will be point protection. Political issues are smoke to the town of Jackson, National Parks and with the National Park celebration of 100 years, there are multiple planned events with VIP's attending. Critical needs include T1 Crews and T3 engines the next few days.
4 Tie IC: Spencer Johnston	800 / 0% / 55 / NR No significant changes from last night's 209. Creating anchor point, then direct and indirect line planned work. Concerns are a major powerline, Hwy 31 (scenic byway from Swan Valley to Victor, ID), Implemented a level I evacuation for 20 residences located just SW of Victor, ID. Some trail closures on FS lands. Critical needs include T1, T2 crews and aviation. (T2 Team ordered just after IC call)
5 Fire: Peterson Hollow IC: Darren Turner John Platt (t)	900+ / 0% / 200 / \$850,000 Again winds contributed to growth of fire. Active last night with spotting up to ½ mile. Closures continue for Trails and FS roads with threats to be Beaver Mtn. Ski area, trout habitat and Garden City. There is also a concern of smoke impacting traffic along Hwy 89. Safety concerns continue to be snags and extreme fire behavior. Critical needs; 1 T1 crews, Scoopers, and T1 helicopter.
6 Clifton IC: Bastian	1000 / 0% / 52 / 65,000 Incident started 8/23, cause unknown, 100% full suppression strategy. Fire Behavior is extreme and running. Fuels are grass and juniper. Showing on 209 evacuations in progress along with area closures. Critical needs are T1 or T2IA crews
7 Fire: Sand Ledges IC: S. Nielson	3,100 / 70% / 94 / \$950,000.00 Dozer line complete. Little work left with some handline building-would like to keep both IA acres today and release tomorrow. No update on investigation of dozer burnover. Issues continue with smoke.
8 Fires: South Fork Zone Big Elk, Carrot, Black Fires IC: Spencer Johnston	3 Fires are being managed together however not a complex. Big Elk 68 acres, inactive, no concerns Carrot 75 acres NE of Driggs, ID in the wilderness, unstaffed Black Fire 200-250 acres north Swan Valley, ID is of concern. Working on a long term implementation plan today
9 Fire: Briggs IC: Clay Matheson	3,347 / 50% / 105 / \$836,000.00 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increased acreage due to better mapping after PSD work a few day ago. • Received .5 inch + of precip yesterday. • Opening up Big Johns Road today and camping area tomorrow • Critical Resource Needs: None
10 Fire: Toponce Creek	265 / 90% / 103 / \$1,600,000.00 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Moving to T4 if held with wind maybe Wed-Thurs

11 Fire: Rock Hill IC: Eric Nolan	1738 / 90% / 166 / \$215,000.00 Securing last piece on E side of fire. Still a little heat in the juniper and really no RH recovery last night. Concerns are still steep, rocky terrain. Will be releasing Black Mtn. IHC tonight.
12 Fire: Rough IC: Rory Anderson	4,122 / 40% / 90 / \$2,100,000.00 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fire continues to move north towards old burn scars, objective to keep fire corralled. N and W side completed. • Gave Pioneer T2 IA crew today.
13 Fire: Porcupine IC: Brandon Hoffman	1900 / 19% / 72 / \$485,000.00 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plans are to hold and monitor. • Area closure on Manti-Lasal/Fishlake • Resources available for release/reassignment: None • Safety Issues: None • Injuries: None • Critical Resource Needs: T1 IA crew
