Fire: Pioneer

In the Long Creek area protecting about 11 homes and continue to clear logs. On DIVS G the only unsecure line is the red area to Crooked River. The fire continues to creep down in the Crooked Road will continue to monitor.

Will lift level 1 evacuations today at 1200 in Pioneerville and hwy 17 up to Lowman. From Lone Peak up will leave in Level 1.

Releasing T2 and T3 helicopter

Injury from several days ago, burn to the hand about the size of a silver dollar is back on light duty.

Look for increase in the % containment in the next several days. However, the N/NW side of the fire is problematic. Resources continue to work on putting indirect line into that area. Road 591 – 579 from Bruce Meadows to Landmark. It looks like the team will be working hard to get indirect line into this area. The fire has potential to continue to move N/NW for a long time.

WX: Continue to dry out for the next 5-7 days. Still dry and resources are trying to do full suppression wherever possible. Long term is dry for the next 7 to 10 days, with no little precipitation in the forecast.

	Aircraft still assigned: 2 Sky Crain's, 2 KMAX, 4 T3s and scoopers. Scoopers are very effective. Looking to see what can be released.
