East of the Lost Creek homes the file will continue to burn into the old Lowman burn.</p> <p>Team will continue to breakdown the Lowman camp and move all of the resources into the Garden Valley camp today.</p> <p>Branch 2 : South of HWY 17: Will monitor this side of the fire. Rehab is almost done and will continue to monitor.</p> <p>Branch 1 : East side: north of HWY 17. Indirect line continues along the 579 to the old Little Beaver fire scar.
