Predictive Services: Weather update:	A cold front will move over the incident today bringing in rain and gusty winds. Rain amounts should be around .1 inch. The rain will last into Sunday afternoon before tapering off in the evening. Mostly cloudy with a 40% chance rain. Highs 51 – 58 on the ridges and 56 – 64 in the Valleys (down 5 to 10 degrees). Another system moves into the area mid-week.

1 Fire: Pioneer IC: Russ Bird	<p>188,397 acres / 494 / 91.5M No changes to the 209. Lowman camp is up and running starting today...still experiencing commo issues per Ron Boillier. Wifi has been crashing so very difficult to call out. Will do their best to contact us to update, but be advised communication is still a challenge.</p> <p>No fire growth yesterday and received .1 to .25 inch precipitation on the fire. The only active line construction took place on DIVS E, small chunk of line put in. Fire is looking really good just two or three spots where heat and do not expect any additional activity, fuels are no longer available with the moisture received, temperature change and expected system anticipated this week.</p> <p>Main mission for this team as they take over the fire will be fire rehab and damage repair. For the next 7-10 days they will be completing suppression repair and accountability of all equipment out on the fire. Will see requests for crews as current crews time-out.</p> <p>There was an incident where a vehicle went off the road yesterday, two folks in the vehicle. SEC2 tipped on its side, both passengers are okay and a wrecker is working to remove the rig. There will be more to follow as information becomes available after the investigation.</p>
