Lowman ICP is established. The fire is not expected to stand up but it is burning within the interior. Ordering in 3 more IHCs due to crews timing out. Looking at the summer homes around Long Creek and planning to move to Stage 1 evacuations after Wednesday. Also, looking to reduce the closure area South of Lowman.

The Baer team is in place and working with the IMT for repairs and restoration around the fire. Crews are working on dangerous snag removal, road improvements and dozer line rehab.

No injuries or accidents to report. No meetings or major safety concerns.

As far as the glide-path. Looking 7-10 days out. There is still a tremendous amount of work to be completed. Team will update accordingly.
