- When VEMs are unavoidable or there is an impact on, or risk to, existing water sources containing invasive species for suppressing fires in VEMs consider and address any:
- Remove or rehabilitate evidence of human intervention to the maximum extent possible
- Repair for suppression-related resource damage immediately
- Plan and implement actions prior to the suppression incident operation distribution
- Repair or rehabilitate evidence of resources not damaged with the same type of equipment that was used for suppression. For example, if motorized earth-mooring equipment was used to construct fire lines, then the same type of equipment may be used to construct and rehabilitate.
- Operations should track daily the amount of mechanical use that occurs on the incident. This task can be completed by the READ CO, DEVS, or delegated to the appropriate level.
