TARGET GROUP: EMR and EMT personnel with current or expired EMS licenses, (either State of Idaho or NREMT). OR with (FS-NPS White card) who need or want additional hand on skills and CE hours under the National Forest Service EMS program or under the Boise NF Idaho EMS license.

TOPIC: The EMS skills training will consist of receiving classroom and hands on skills training from BTE EMS trainers. This 2-day session will review/discuss EMS expectations under the overall FS EMS program 'umbrella', as well as practicing Emergency Medical Skills., it will cover FA/ CPR certification as well as other EMS practical skills.

Also, a great opportunity to ask questions. Other material that we will be reviewing is the National EMS Program and NPS FM 51 Protocols, the Medical Supervision Plan, and a few other documents.
