- DESCRIPTION: The D-110 course provides students with the skills to perform as an expanded dispatch recorder (EDRC). Topics include the structure of the expanded dispatch organization, description of resource ordering and statusing process, and the importance of the EDRC having effective communication skills and working relationships. As well, participants will get an introduction, general overview and hands-on of Interagency Resource Ordering Capability (IROC) application.
Class size will be limited 20 students.
- TARGET GROUP: Individuals who have had no previous training or experience in the dispatch function and who will be called on as needed to assist in the expanded or initial attack dispatch organization. EDRC is a FS-FPM IFPM requirement.
- PREREQUISITES: Required: Students must bring their own laptop.
