DESCRIPTION:	This course is designed to meet the training requirements outlined in NIMS: Wildland Fire Qualification System Guide, PMS 310-1 and the position task book developed for Wildland Fire Investigator (INVF). The primary purpose of this course is to provide a consistent knowledge and skill base for Wildland Fire Investigator. The concepts taught in this course will help an INVF perform at an acceptable level on a national basis without regard to geographic boundaries.		
RESPONSIBILITIES:	There is pre-course work and pre-selection assessment (estimate 2 hours). All students are required to bring full-firefighting PPE to class for field exercises. In addition to Nomex clothing, initial attack fire packs (fire shelter only packs) are acceptable.		
TARGET GROUP:	Recommended training for experienced fire personnel with wildland fire investigation responsibilities.		
PREREQUISITES:	Satisfactory completion of the pre-selection assessment and pre-course work.		
SCHEDULE:	May 22-26, 2023 - in-person training in the Expanded Dispatch Room, Boise District BLM from 0800-1700 each day.		
COST:	No Tuition – Student travel and per diem costs are the responsibility of the sending unit.
