### S-271 Helicopter Crewmember

DESCRIPTION: This training is a combined classroom/field course designed to provide student proficiency in all areas of the tactical and logistical use of helicopters to achieve efficiency and standardization. Topics include aviation safety, aircraft capabilities and limitations, aviation life support equipment, aviation mishap reporting, pre-flight checklist and briefing/debriefing, aviation transportation of hazardous materials, crash survival, helicopter operations, and helicopter field exercise. This course contains the following IAT modules and will be awarded the training competencies of A-105, A-113, and A-219 upon completion. **Class size is limited to 20 students.**

TARGET GROUP: Personnel involved in fire and non-fire project assignments with helicopters PREREQUISITES:

Non-fire personnel – None
