

Central Idaho Interagency Fire Center 2012 Annual Report

Salmon-Challis National Forest Salmon and Challis Field Offices – Idaho Falls District BLM



A record number of acres – 429,063 – burned within the Central Idaho Fire Zone during the 2012 fire season. Field-going Forest personnel began a mandatory check-in process with CIFC which caused an overall increase in radio communications and phone calls.

Incident Summary


In general, business within Central Idaho Fire Center (CIFC) was near normal. A total of 401 incidents were created, slightly below the office's 10-year average of 437.


Three of the four Search and Rescue incidents were to assist Lemhi County; the remaining one was an assist to Custer County. USFS aviation resources assisted with two of the searches.

The majority of the Miscellaneous incidents were related to preparedness scenarios and training.

Agency personnel assisted

Lemhi County on 5 fires on private land, including the Tenmile Fire that burned about 440 acres of BLM land.





FIRE ACTIVITY

The first fire of 2012 was reported to the North Fork Ranger District on February 20th and was human-caused. The last new fire of the year was reported on October 17th and called out the following day.

July was the busiest month for initial attack with 50 new fires. The largest bust occurred between July 27th and August 1st, when 37 new fires were recorded, including both the Halstead and Mustang Fires. The single busiest day for new fires was July 28th with 11 new fires.

The Salmon-Challis National Forest eclipsed its former record of 417,260 acres that burned in 2000. The number of fires reported was more consistent with historical trends, whereas the past few years have seen very low numbers.

The Salmon Field Office of the Idaho Falls District saw an increase in fire activity in 2012 as well. Though not near the 6,714 acres burned in 2003, the office documented the 5th highest acreage on record.



UARGE FIRES

The Kriley and Tenmile Fires were both contained the day following ignition and managed by initial attack incident commanders. The Merino Fire was minimally staffed under the direction of contiguous


2 2012 Central Idaho Dispatch Annual Report



The Halstead Fire was initially going to be managed by a Type 3 Team; however, conditions necessitated higher management and a National Incident Management Organization was ordered on July 30th. The team also directed initial attack on 3 fires, including the Bench Fire. The Halstead Fire impacted 171,638 acres of the SCNF and 10,310 acres of the Sawtooth National Forest.

A Type 3 Team was in place on the Mustang Fire on August 1st. The Mustang Complex was formally created on August 6th, when a Type 2 Team was ordered. The Complex eventually grew to a total of 341,488 acres, connecting 8 fires on the S-CNF as well as the Hamilton Fire on the Bitterroot National Forest and the Cabin Springs Fire on the Nez Perce National Forest. Additionally, both the Lost Packer and Mustang Fires burned over the forest boundary and onto the Bitterroot National Forest.


CIFC scheduled a near-normal number of flights both for fire and administration business despite the extremely smoky conditions which limited air navigation on many days in August and September. The majority of flights (41) were conducted from Challis to one of the backcountry airstrips along the Middle Fork of the Salmon River. Most of the contracted flights were scheduled through Middle Fork Aviation, with occasional service by McCall/Salmon Air. A few flights were completed using agency

aircraft from the Payette National Forest.

Half of the scheduled Fire Detection flights were completed with the use of aircraft ordered through ROSS and assigned either to large incidents or available for initial attack. Reconnaissance flights include those conducted by both fixed and rotor-wing aircraft. CIFC provided flight following to Idaho Fish and Game for a total of 32 days this year.
