

.DISCUSSION...PERSISTENT LIGHT NORTHERLY WINDS ALOFT THROUGH SUNDAY OVER SOUTHEAST IDAHO LEAD TO INCREASED SUBSIDENCE AND SURFACE BASED INVERSIONS...REDUCED VENTILATION...LOWER DAYTIME HUMIDITY AND RECOVERY OVER NIGHT BECOMING POOR. IN THE UPPER SNAKE PLAIN...A PATTERN OF REPEAT GUSTY NORTHEAST WINDS DEVELOP AT NIGHT AND DIMINISH DURING THE DAY.
