

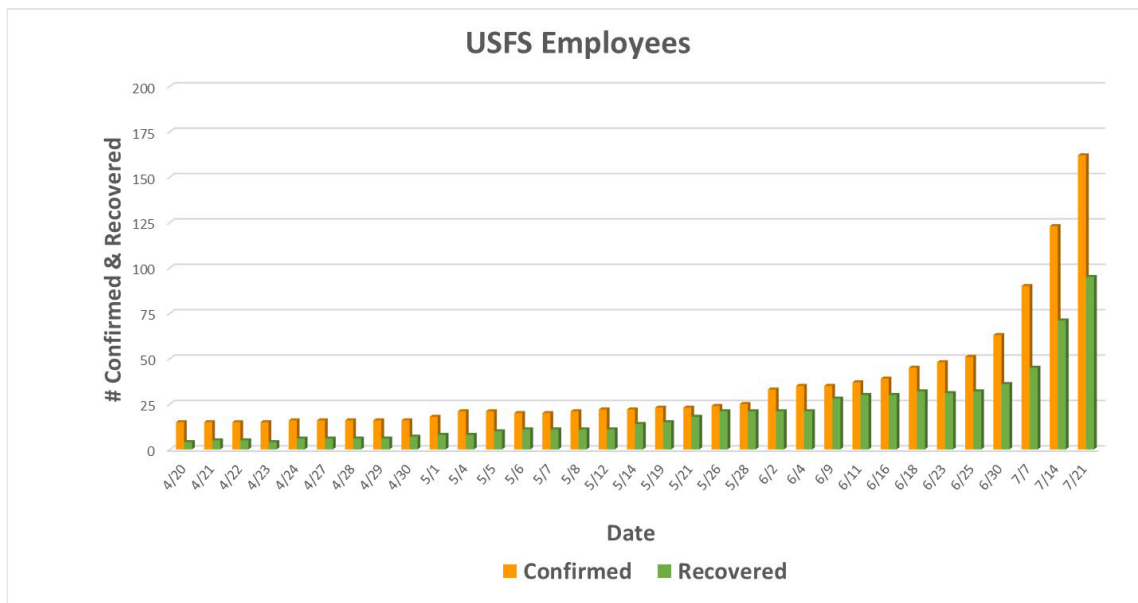


# Fire & Aviation SAFETY ADVISORY



## The work we do is dangerous, COVID-19 is making it worse

We are seeing a steep rise in cases of coronavirus in our Forest Service, and especially our wildland fire communities. Let's do our part to mitigate this risk through our core values.



**DUTY** – It is our duty to do our jobs safely. Safety includes following these CDC guidelines:

- Wearing a Mask (where feasible)
- Washing your Hands (where you can)
- Maintaining Social Distancing (in briefings and around camp)

**RESPECT** – Have respect for your crew, your family and yourself by following the CDC guidelines above both on and off duty. When in the office or vehicles with your co-workers, wear a mask to respect the “Module as One”. Remember your off-duty behavior will influence the health and well being of your crew and their families too.

**INTEGRITY** – Do all of these things even when no one is watching. This way you show up for everyone in your life in the best way you can.
