# Color Country Interagency Fire Center

Color Country Interagency Fire Center (CCIFC) response area is approximately 16.4 million acres of Federal, State, and Private Lands. CCIFC dispatches for the following agencies: Color Country District Office BLM (CDC) Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument BLM (GSENM), Arizona Strip District Office BLM (ASD), Dixie National Forest (DIF), Zion National Park (ZIP), Glen Canyon National Recreation Area (GLP), Bryce Canyon National Park (BRP), Cedar Breaks National Monument (CBP), Grand Canyon-Parashant and Vermillion Cliffs National Monuments BLM, Pipe Spring National Monument, Southern Paiute Field Office BIA (SPA), Fish and Wildlife Services (FWS), Utah Division of Forestry, Fire, and State Lands (SWS) which includes the five southwest counties of Utah, and State of Arizona (A2S2).

The 2015 wildland fire season started with light IA in April and then it picked up in June. CCIFMA received periodic monsoonal moisture leaving us with low ERC's and a below average fire season. The ERC's stayed below average for the majority of the fire season. There were a total of 267 fires for 3,035 acres this season. Human caused fires accounted for 24% of all fires and 3% of the total acres burned. The State of Utah accounted for 47% of the human caused fires for 77% of the human caused acres. CCIFC ended the season with 284 wildfires, 13 incorporated assists, and 140 false alarms. Color Country mobilized three T3 teams. Chris Henrie's T3 team was assigned to the Mount Emma and High Meadow fires (both fires Arizona Strip BLM). Eric Eastep's T3 team was on the Oak Grove fire (Pine Valley Ranger District). Color Country resources responded to 424 smoke reports this season.

Color Country Interagency Fire Management Area was the host of 5 exclusive use aircraft for 2015: one - T1 (HT-793) helicopter at CDC, one -T3 (H-7BS) Helicopter at SGU, one -Air Attack (AA-0FD) at CDC, and 2 SEATs at the Cedar City Air Center (T-811 & T-812). Color Country Air Center / Cedar City Tanker Base pumped 249,397 gallons of retardant.

CCIFC processed approximately 9,230 ROSS orders for aircraft, overhead, crews, equipment, and supplies. CCIFC was unable to fill (UTF) 236 local and non-local incident orders. These orders do not include local resources sent during initial attack which are not captured within ROSS. CCIFC supported incidents outside of the CCIFC area by sending 210 - Overhead, 53 – Aircraft, 6 - Crews, and 57 - Engines off-unit. We appreciate all those who took assignments and helped with the fire effort.

The Mount Emma fire started June 24<sup>th</sup> on the Grand Canyon Parashant N.M. (ASD BLM land) and burned onto the Grand Canyon National Park. The fire was started by lightning just west of Mount Emma. Shannon Orr (Boise Smokejumper) transitioned to Chris Henrie's T3 IMT on June 26th. The Mount Emma final size was 4,218 acres.



The High Meadow fire was started by lightning July 14<sup>th</sup> on the Arizona Strip District BLM northeast of Mount Logan. Colt Coates transitioned to Chris Henrie's T3 IMT on July 28th. Fires final size was 1,342 acres.



The Oak Grove fire was started by lightning September 8<sup>th</sup> on the Pine Valley Ranger District of the Dixie National forest. The fire was located northwest of Leeds, UT in the Pine Valley Wilderness. Adam Heyder transitioned to Eric Eastep's T3 IMT on September 10th. Fires final size was 943 acres.

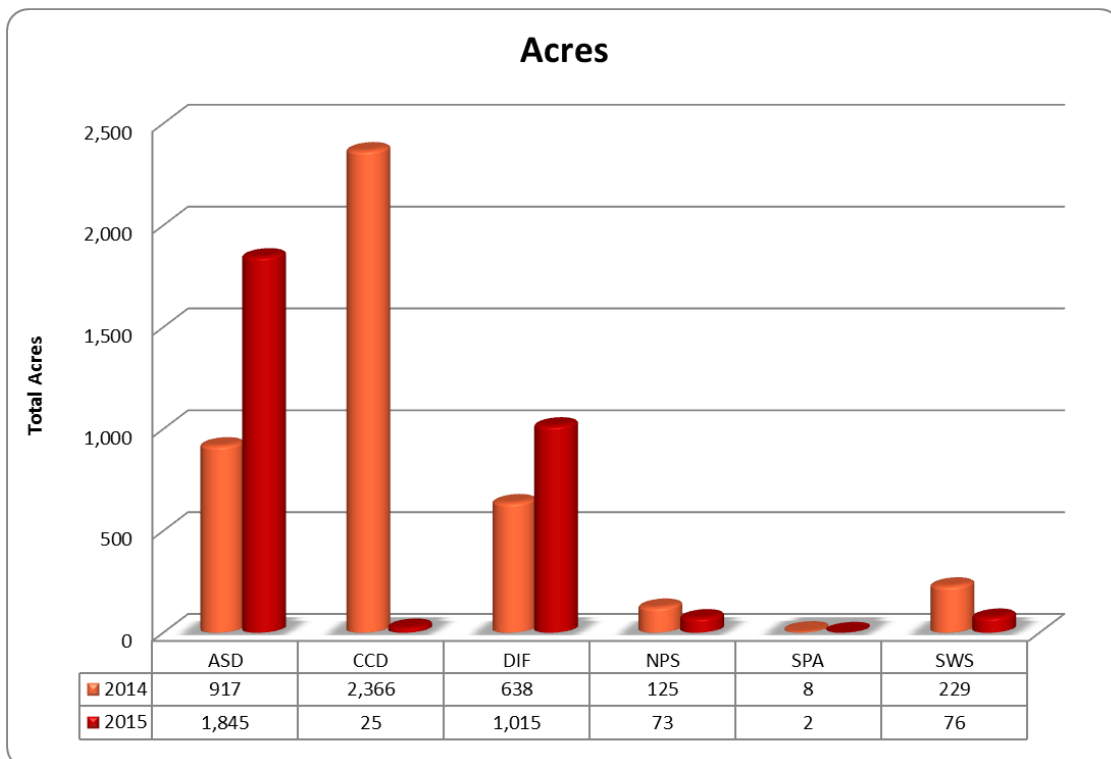
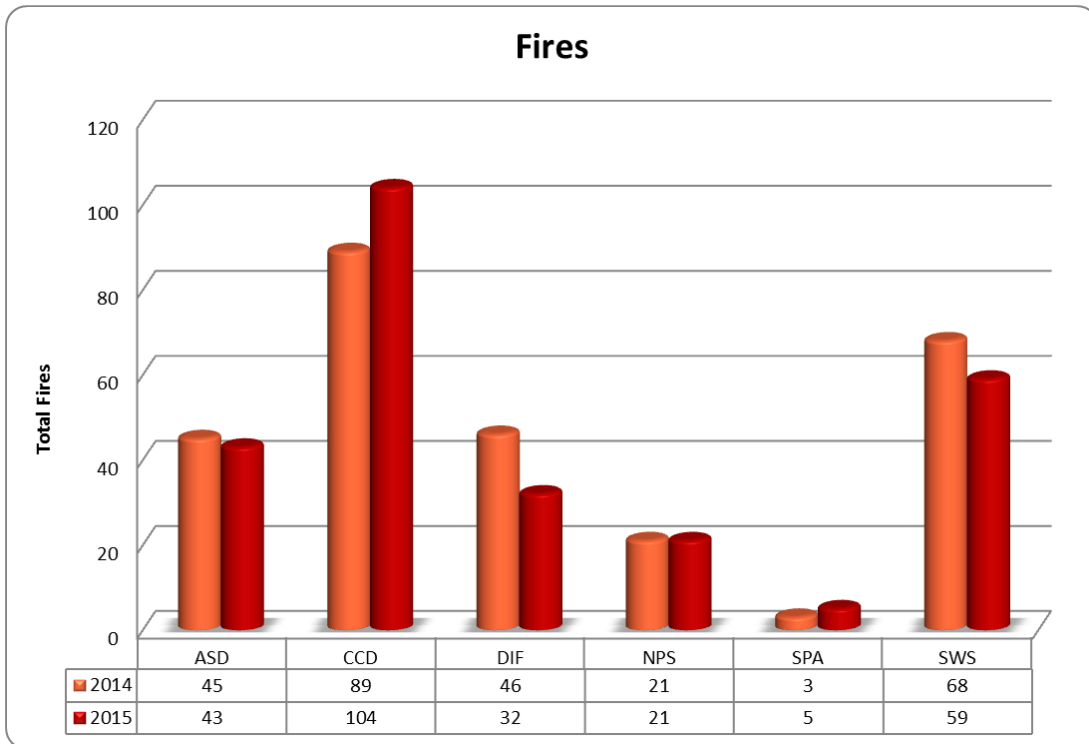
### PERCENT OF TOTAL FIRES BY AGENCY



### PERCENT OF TOTAL ACRES BY AGENCY

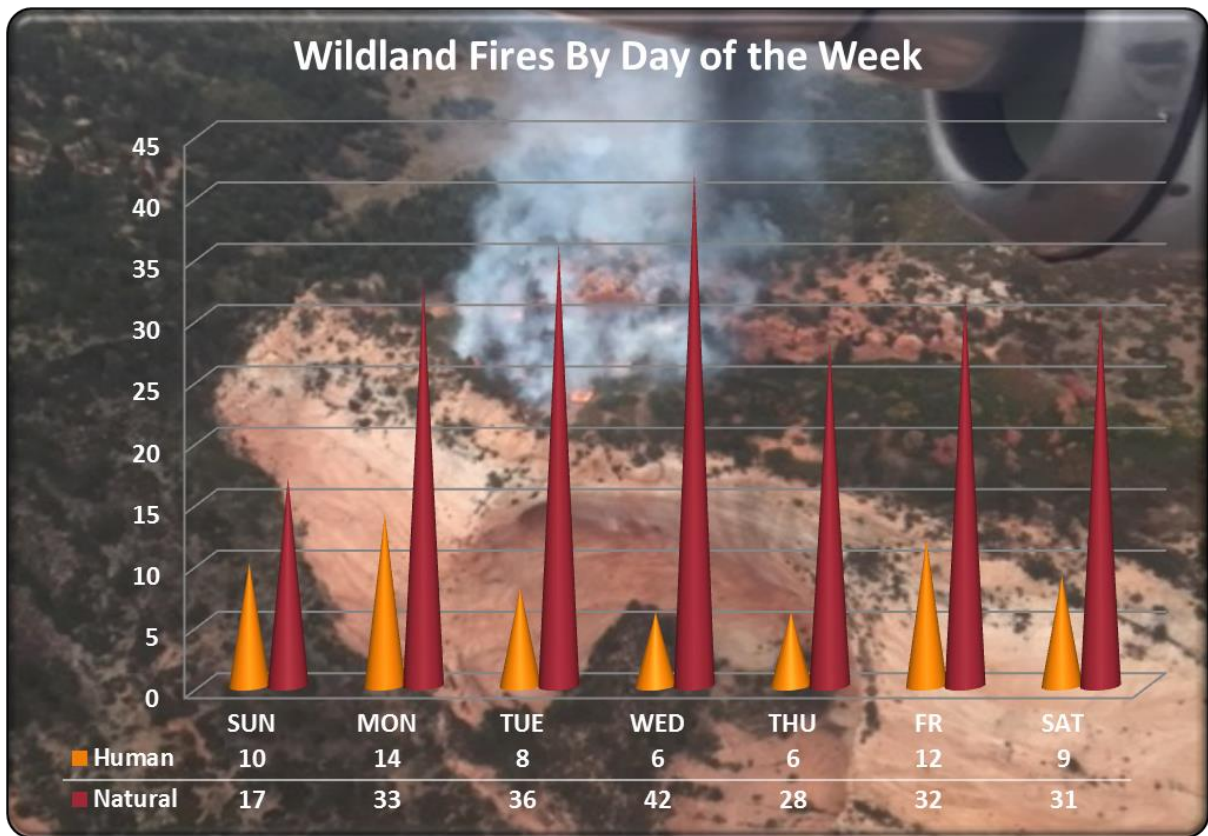

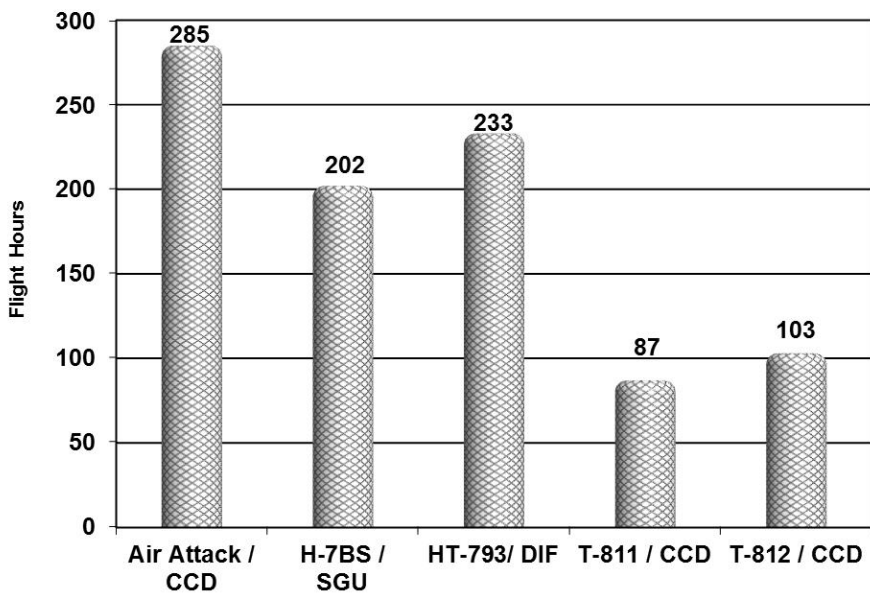

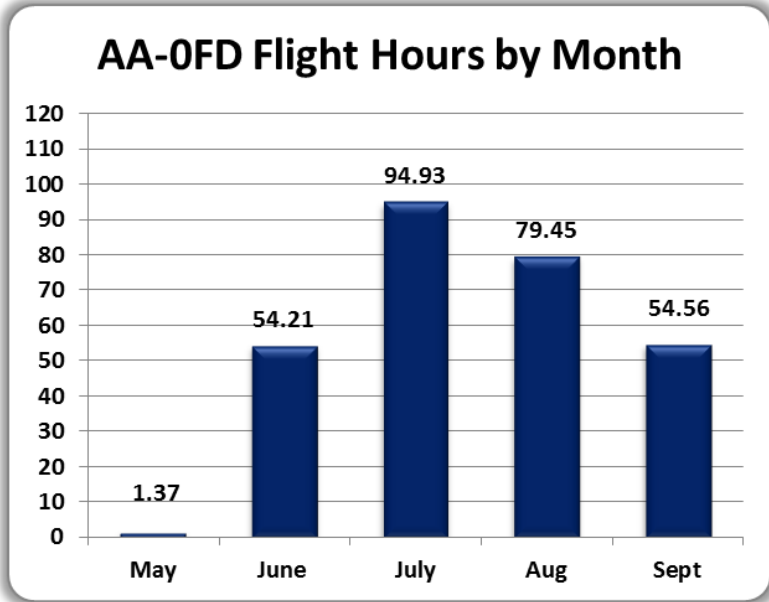
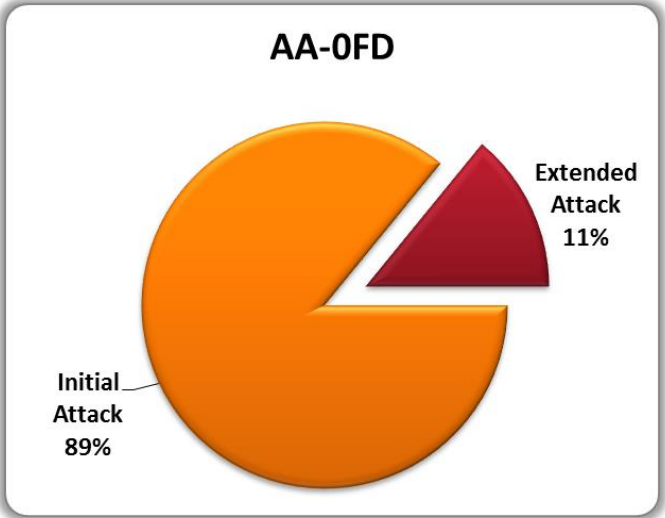
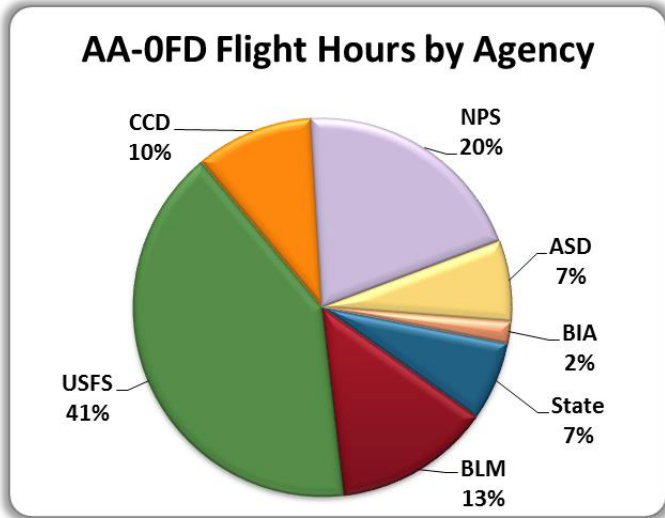
### Aircraft Utilization 5yr. Comparison

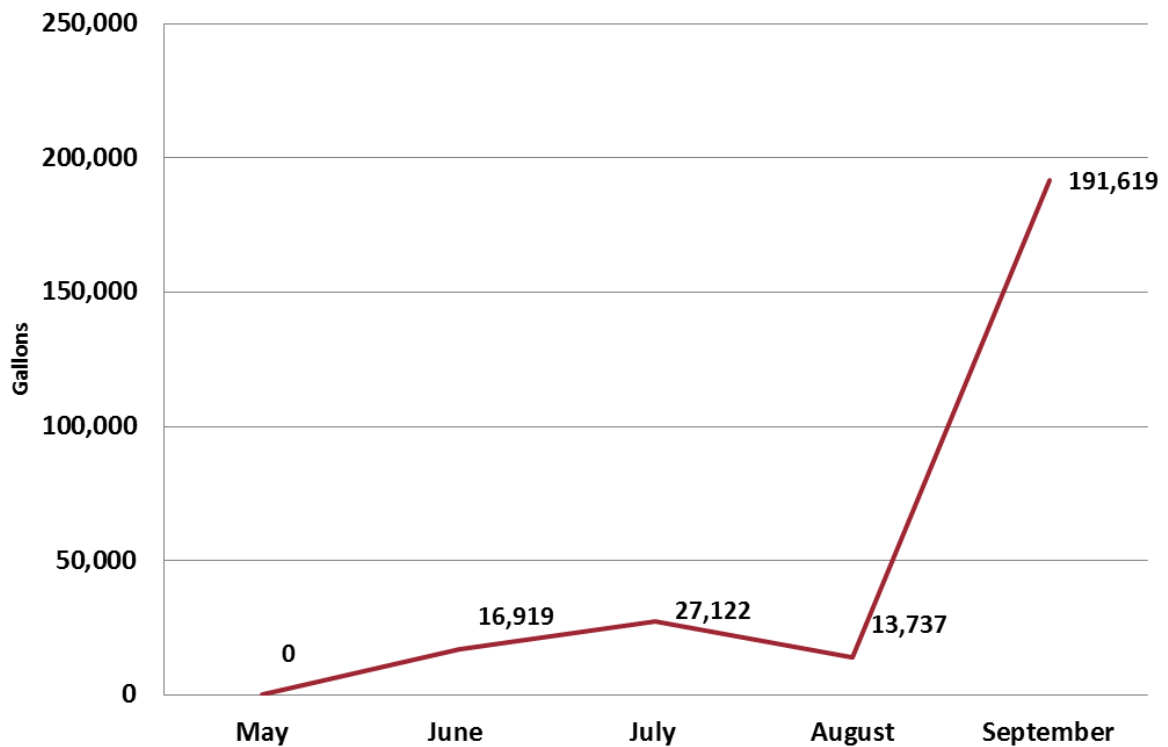

### Retardant Distribution in CCIFMA

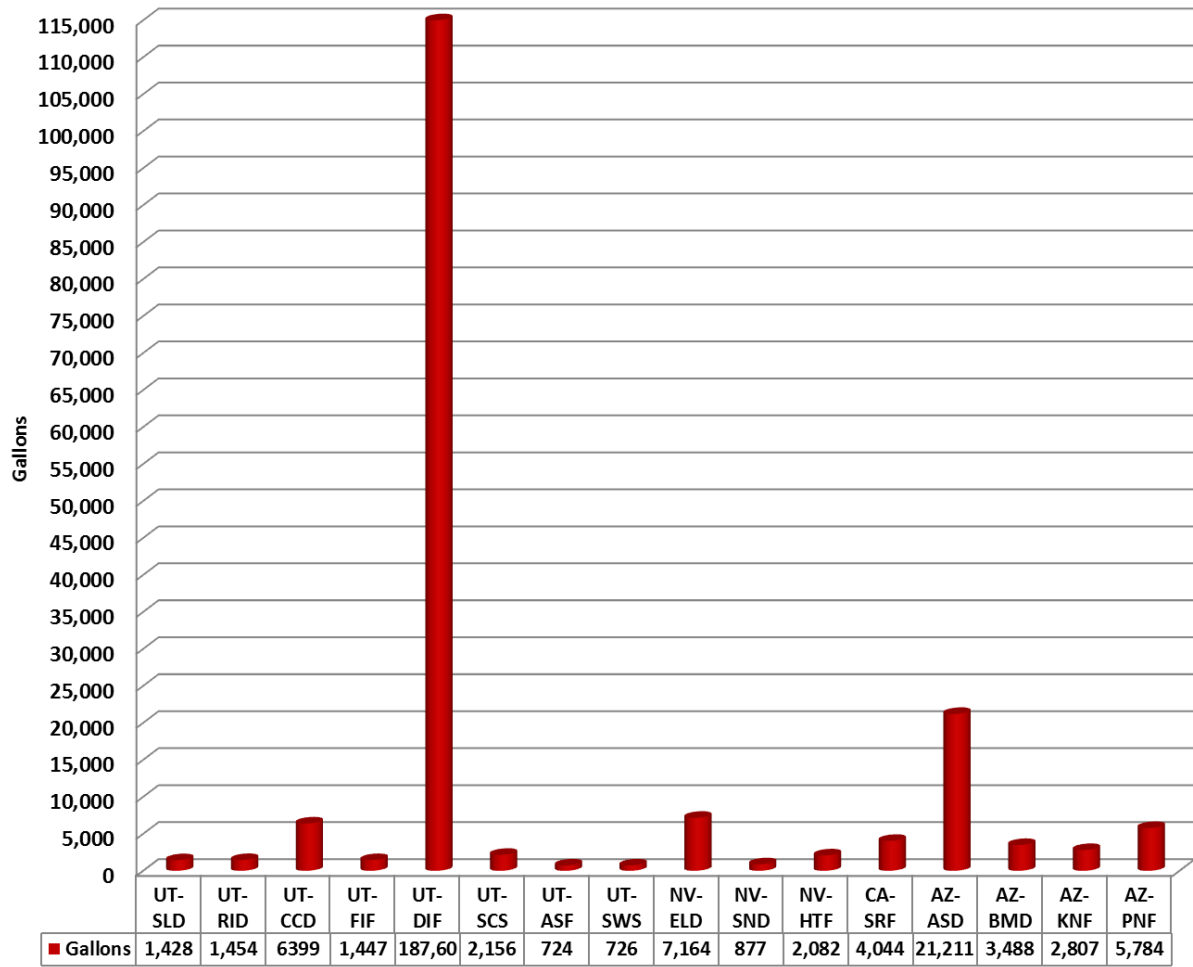


### Retardant Pumped by Month
